Grapheme/Phoneme Assessment Record

Place the grapheme sheet in front of the student. Use a masking card so that the student can only see one row at a time. Ask the student to provide the phoneme for each grapheme. For graphemes that can represent more than one phoneme, ask the student if they know another sound that can be represented by the phoneme.
