- <a>/ă/ (e.g., "cat"), <o>/ŏ/ (e.g., "on")
- <c>/k/, <g>/g/, <s>/s/ unvoiced (e.g., "sat")
- <d>/d/, <h>/h/, <m>/m/, <n>/n/, /p/, <t>/t/

## **Orthographic Conventions**

- short vowel sounds in closed syllables
- <c> as default grapheme for /k/

#### Punctuation/Text Features

- concept of phrase and sentence
- period at end of complete sentence
- exclamation mark
- capitalization of proper nouns

### **High Frequency Words**

- "a" (<a> typically pronounced as a schwa)
