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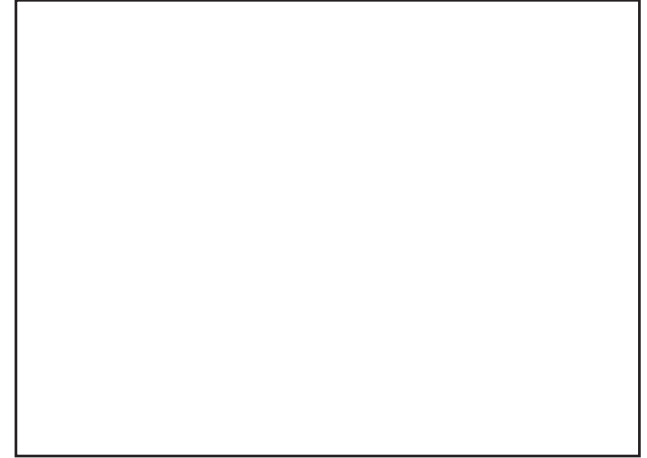

Orthographic Conventions - short vowel sounds in closed syllables - <c> as default grapheme for /k/	High-Frequency Words - “a” (<a> typically pronounced as a <i>schwa</i>)
Morphology - n/a	Word Count - 24 words

Orthographic Conventions - concept of digraph	High-Frequency Words - “the” (<e> typically pronounced as a schwa) - “and” (<nd> is the only consonant cluster in the Yellow Series, and is only used in “and”)
